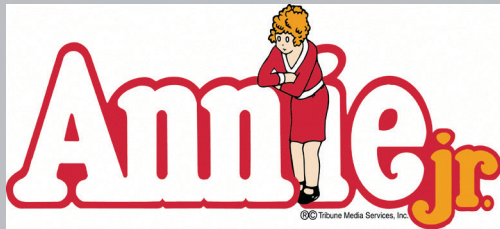

Our Immersion program builds confidence and self-esteem for area students through exploration of the dramatic arts. It helps young people to find their voice and to experience working collaboratively with students of different ages and backgrounds. We teach structure and discipline to students at a young age, and instill respect and responsibility for all people on a diverse team.

In 9 years, our training has led area students to perform in Chicago, South Bend, and NYC, and has helped students succeed in being admitted to college arts and academic programs. Research shows that young people who participate in the arts are 4x more likely to be recognized for academic achievement.

Participation will require a pre-audition and some independent work before July 21. The selection will only go forward if all key roles are filled in advance.

Alternative selections for teens if Les Mis does not go forward due to casting will be "A Midsummer Night's Dream" by William Shakespeare, or "James and the Giant Peach Jr."
